

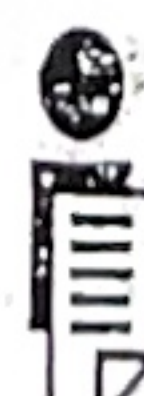

### ORDER

- Whereas, the AICTE is a statutory body established by AICTE Act, 1987. The said Act "provides for establishment of an All India Council for Technical Education with a view to the proper planning a coordinated development of the technical education system throughout the country, the promotion qualitative improvement of such education in relation to planned quantitative growth and the regulation proper maintenance of norms and standards in the technical education system and for matters connect therewith."
- Whereas, Section 10 of the AICTE Act prescribes the function of the Council and mandates that it shall the duty of the Council to take all necessary steps as it may think fit for ensuring coordinated and integrat development of technical education and maintenance of standards. Further, Section 10 (k) of the AICT Act, empowers the AICTE to grant approval for starting new Technical Institutions and for introduction new courses or programmes in consultation with the agencies concerned.
- Whereas, in order to discharge its duties in accordance with the provisions contained in the AICTE Act the AICTE has framed the regulations for grant of approval for starting new Technical Institutions, introduction of courses or programmes and increase / variation of intake capacity of seats for the courses or programme of existing Technical Institutions. The AICTE has also evolved a Hand book for approval process which details out the procedure as well as minimum conditions which an Institute must fulfill in order to sec approval for either starting new Technical Institutions or for introduction of courses / programmes a increase / variation of intake capacity of seat for courses / programmes as well as existing Technica Institute.
- Whereas, College of Art, 20-22, Tilak Marg, East Delhi, New Delhi-110001 was approved in the year 1945 and subsequent EOAs were issued upto 2018-19 for running Applied Arts and Craft Programs.
- Whereas, the Institute was granted EOA for the year 2018-19 along with the portal generated deficiency based on self-disclosure. The deficiencies were required to be complied within six months.
- Whereas, Scrutiny committee was conducted by RO, NWRO, followed by SAC, where the Committee ha recommended for "No Admission" for A. Y. 2019-20 due to faculty deficiency by 83% and non-compliance other deficiencies related to anti-ragging, Admin Area, Amenities, and computational facilities etc
- Whereas, the Principal Secretaries of the concerned States vide letter No. AICTE/AB/NWR/Gov Institutes/Compliance/2019-20 and letter No. F. No. NWRO/AICTE/All States Govt./2018-19 date 30.03.2019 were informed about the punitive action recommended by the Scrutiny / SHC / SAC and wa requested for compliance of the deficiencies.
- Whereas, in response to AICTE's letters the Joint Director (Planning), Directorate of Training & Technical Education, Govt. of Delhi vide letter no. F. No. 161(111)/Acad./AICTE/Its/2019-20/4615 dated 28.02.2019 has requested for retaining of existing intake capacity for the A. Y. 2019-20 and mentioned that all principal have been advised to initiate action to remove the deficiencies.
- Whereas, the request of the Joint Director (Planning), Directorate of Training & Technical Education, Govt of Delhi was placed in 124<sup>th</sup> EC Meeting vide Item No. 124.03.02 and in 57<sup>th</sup> Council Meeting vide Item


No. 57.04.02 both were held on 08.04.2019. The EC and Council have deliberated on the proposal of granting EOA to Govt. Institutions and after deliberations, the EC decided that *"based on the commitments received from respective State Government for compliance of deficiencies, a Committee of three academicians be constituted and severity of deficiencies be assessed. If deficiencies are severe in nature, appropriate action, ranging from reduction between 10 to 20% be imposed."*

0. Whereas, the matter was placed before the Committee as per decision of the Council and EC. The Committee recommended ~~for 20% reduction in intake for A. Y. 2019-20~~ due to infrastructural deficiency and shortage of faculty of 16% in A. Y. 2019-20.

11. Therefore, after examining the entire matter in the facts and circumstances mentioned herein above, and in terms of the provision of the Approval Process Hand Book, for the A/Y 2019-20 and also the terms and conditions mentioned in the Letter of Approval, it has been decided to grant *Extension of Approval for A. Y. 2019-20 with 20% reduction in intake* to College of Art, 20-22, Tilak Marg, East Delhi, New Delhi-110001.

12. It may be noticed that clause 2.5.3 of Approval Process Handbook 2019-20 is implemented on the courses run by the Institutes, wherever applicable.

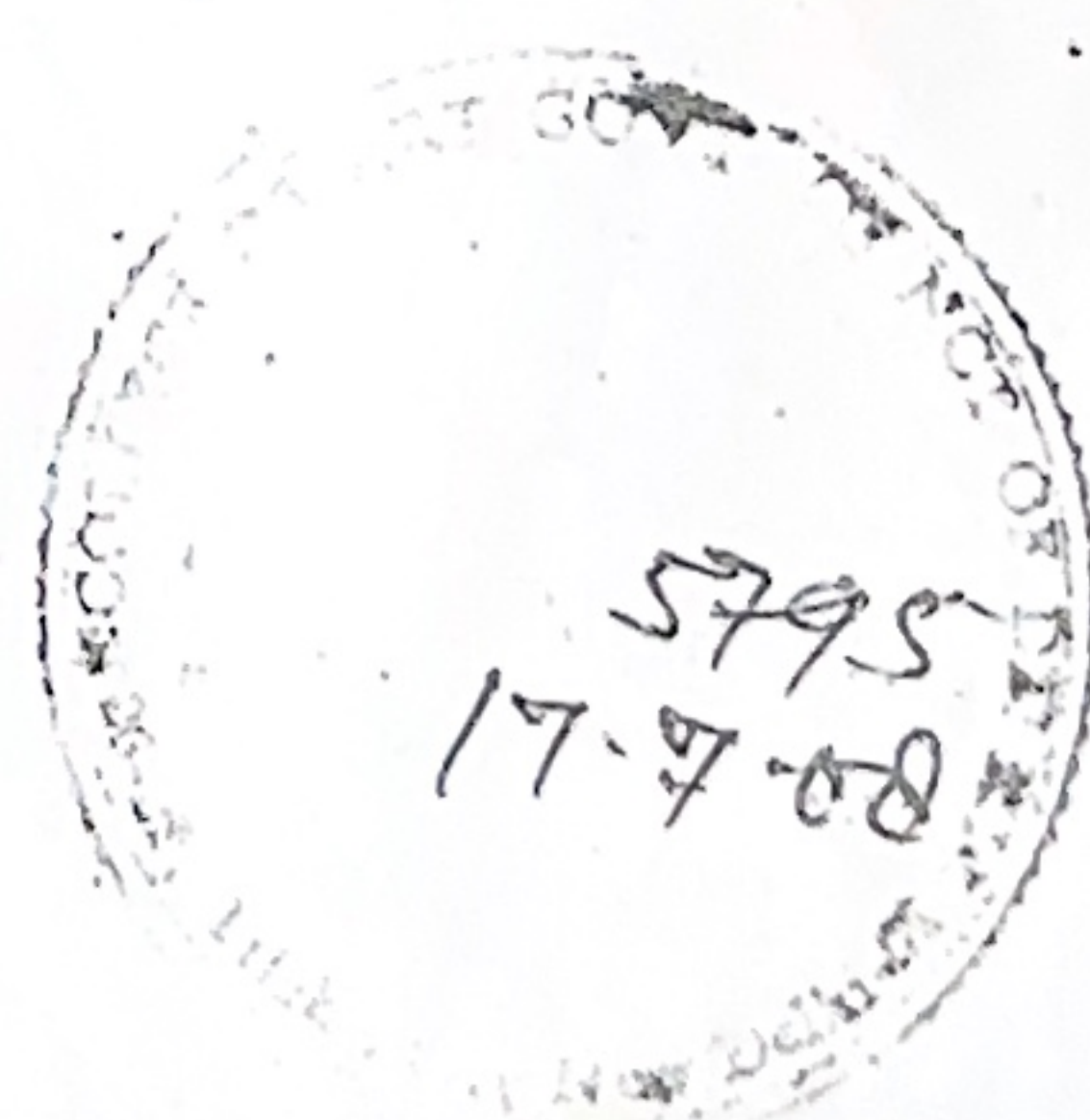

The Board passed the following two Resolutions to mourn the sudden and untimely demise of Prof.Nayudamma and his wife Dr.(Mrs)Pavanamma Nayudamma.

#### RESOLUTION-I.

"The members of the All India Board of Post-Graduate Studies and Research in Engineering and Technology deeply mourn the sad,sudden and untimely demise of Prof.Y.Nayudamma, Chairman of the Board in tragic circumstances on June 23,1985.

While noting the action taken on the recommendations made by the Board at its last meeting, the Board observed as under:

(1) The Board made it clear that all M.Sc Courses being conducted Engineering Colleges and Engineering Departments of the

(2) With regard to the funding of the Post-Graduate Courses on hundred per cent basis by the UGC and the Central Government, Dr. Gupta, Joint Secretary, UGC informed the Board that the matter is under the active consideration of the University Grants Commission. The members of the Board were of the view that all Post-Graduate Courses/programmes in Engineering and Technology should be funded uniformly on 100% basis as is done by the Ministry of Education. The members further suggested that if the University Grants Commission was not in a position to take up this responsibility, the Ministry of Education should take up this responsibility even in respect of the Engineering Departments of the Universities.

(3) The Board had a discussion regarding the continuance of two-year duration for some specialized Courses and reiterated its earlier decision that as far as possible all post-graduate programmes should fall in line with the recommendations of the Nayudamma Committee, i.e. all post-graduate courses should be of three semesters duration. In this connection Shri M.M. Choudhury informed the Board that the School of Planning and Architecture has accepted the three-semester pattern for their post-graduate programme in Town and Country Planning. The Board decided that after the information was collected by the Secretariat from the institutions concerned, the matter may be placed before the Board at its next meeting for further consideration.

(4) The Board authorised its Screening-Committee to award Ph.D fellowships in Engineering and also recommended that, over and above the fellowships, a suitable contingent grant should also be provided along with Ph.D fellowships.

Item No. 3: To report the setting up of a Coordinating Committee of GATE.

The members suggested that the words "or his binnee" appearing at serial Nos. 1, 2, 4, 6 and 14 of Annexure-III-A should be deleted. Further at serial No. 4, name of Dr. V. C. Kulandaswamy should be mentioned instead of only his designation. The Board was very happy with the composition of the Coordinating Committee and congratulated the Secretariat and the Ministry on the action taken by them.

Item No. 4: To report the review of Post-Graduate Programme in Engineering and Technology.

The members noted the review made by the Secretariat in collaboration with the Indian Society for Technical Education and desired that

The Board further desired that in addition to presentation of a detailed analysis may be carried out by the ISTE in collaboration with the Secretariat of the Board.

- (iii) For the future it was decided that this information be collected on annual basis.

Item No. 5: To report about reconstitution of the Board for its 8th term.

Noted. The Board noted that the present Screening Committee will continue its work of examining fresh proposals for the introduction of post-graduate courses as well as in other matters that are referred to the Committee.

Item No. 6: To consider the question of conducting GATE examination in Hindi.

The Board endorsed the recommendation of its Screening Committee that at present there is not a single Degree course in Engineering/Technology which is being conducted in Hindi or any other regional language. Since the minimum qualification for admission in GATE is a degree in Engineering/Technology, the Board recommended that GATE may be continued to be conducted in English for the present.

Item No. 7: To consider the recommendation made by the Screening Committee at its 7th meeting held on 24-4-1985.

The Board approved the recommendations made by the Screening Committee at its seventh meeting.

Item No. 8: To consider new directions in which the Board might work in future.

The Board noted that Prof. Ashoka Chandra, Educational Adviser (T), after having discussions, had suggested the setting up of a Committee to look into the present terms of reference of the Board and to recommend what changes, if any, are required. The composition of the Committee is as follows:-

The Board endorsed the formation of the above Committee. In this connection, Prof. Ashoka Chandra, Educational Adviser(Tech) mentioned that a National Education Policy is being formulated and a separate discussion on post-graduate education will be held in this context.

Item No. 9: To consider the question of providing financial assistance to State-level institutions conducting part-time post-graduate programmes.

The Board discussed this matter in great detail and endorsed the recommendation of its Screening-Committee that a contingent grant of Rs. 2000/- per student per annum upto a maximum of a total of Rs. 4500/- per student per course be provided for the part-time Courses after these have been duly considered by the Screening-Committee. With regard to the students sponsored by the Industry, the Board was of the view that efforts should be made to persuade the Industry to meet the contingent grant in respect of their sponsored candidates as far as possible. The Board further decided that the matter may be reviewed after a period 2-3 years.

Item No. 10: To note the recommendation made by a Working Group for development of Manpower in the field of computers.



decided that, since the Bachelors Degree programme in this comes under the purview of the All India Council for Technical Education, the Masters Degree Course in this subject will have to be approved by the All India Council for Technical Education and its Post-Graduate Board. Taking note of the fact that post-graduate Courses in three subjects, i.e. Painting, Sculpture and Applied Art have already been considered by the Academic and Executive Council of the University of Delhi and have been approved by the University Grants Commission, the Board, as a special case, agreed to the introduction of these three postgraduate Courses from the academic year 1985-86 with an intake of 7 students in each subject.

The Board further decided that:

- (i) The College of Art, Delhi should redesign these courses to be of three semesters duration and fall in line with the other post-graduate programmes as per the recommendations of the Nayudamma Committee.
- (ii) Since no GATE examination has been conducted in these areas, the Board exempted the College from making admission through GATE for the year 1985-86. However, scholarship will be payable only to those students who have secured atleast 60% marks in the qualifying examination.
- (iii) The College/Delhi Administration may be advised that in future no post-graduate programme should be started unless the same has been considered by the Screening Committee of the Post-Graduate Board in advance.
- (iv) It was noted that the College has the necessary infrastructure by way of accommodation and other basic facilities. Accordingly it was recommended that post-graduate scholarships may be paid according to the norms to those who fulfil the minimum qualification prescribed for the purpose.

Item No. 13: To consider the Report of Visit made by the Screening Committee to the Regional Engineering College, Srinagar in June, 1985.

The Post-Graduate Board approved the recommendation made by its Screening Committee for introduction of a post-graduate Course in 'Water Resources Development' with an annual intake of 10 students and duration of 3 semesters. The Board also approved of the physical facilities and other recommendations made by the Screening Committee.

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the Chair.
