REGISTRATIONS AND ADMISSIONS TO POSTGRADUATE PROGRAMMES

1. REGULAR STUDENTS

➤ TWO-YEAR PG PROGRAMMES

The candidate must be a citizen of India.

For admissions to Two-year Postgraduate Programmes at University of Delhi, all candidates (including those applying under supernumerary quota) must appear for CUET (PG)-2026 at www.nta.ac.in at <https://exams.nta.ac.in/CUET-PG/>. For seat allocations and admissions University of Delhi, candidates must apply to the Common Seat Allocation System (CSAS(PG)-2026) of University of Delhi.

Important:

- **Seat Allocations and Admissions to all Two-Year Postgraduate Programmes (except SOL and Foreign Students) will be done through Common Seat Allocation System (CSAS(PG) - 2026).**
- **Details related to Allocations and Admissions through CSAS (PG) - 2026 will be notified separately on the admission website of UoD (www.admission.uod.ac.in). Candidates must visit the admission website of UoD on regular basis.**

➤ ONE-YEAR PG PROGRAMMES

One-year PG will be offered to the students who have completed Four-Year Bachelor's Degree under NEP from the University of Delhi.

For admissions to One-Year Postgraduate Programmes at University of Delhi, all candidates must refer to the admission website of UoD (www.admission.uod.ac.in).

2. SCHOOL OF OPEN LEARNING (SOL)

Candidates desirous of taking admission in SOL must register at www.sol.du.ac.in and visit the website on regular basis.

3. NON-COLLEGIATE WOMEN'S EDUCATION BOARD (NCWEB)

Female candidates from National Capital Territory (NCT) desirous of taking admission in PG programmes offered by NCWEB, University of Delhi must appear for CUET (PG)- 2026. For detail regarding the examination, the candidate must visit www.nta.ac.in at <https://exams.nta.ac.in/CUET-PG/>. For seat allocations and admissions, candidates must apply to the Common Seat Allocation System (CSAS(PG)-2026) of University of Delhi.

4. FOREIGN NATIONALS

10% of Supernumerary seats in each Programmes are reserved for Foreign Nationals. Candidates seeking admission under the Foreign Students' category are required to apply on Foreign Students' registry website at fsr.du.ac.in.

No fee shall be refunded in such cases. If the same is found after completing the course, the candidate's degree will be cancelled and appropriate legal action will be taken against him/her.
- The University of Delhi will not be responsible for any change/modification in the papers/structure/mode of examinations/dates/ grievances related to CUET (PG) - 2026.
- The University of Delhi is liable to change/modify its admission policies and processes at any time without giving any prior notification. The latest and updated information will be available on the admission website.

IMPORTANT POINTS

1. This Bulletin of Information (BoI) should be referred for admission to Two-Year Postgraduate Programmes at the University of Delhi (UoD) through CUET(PG)-2026. The UoD will publish a separate BoI for the admission to One-Year Postgraduate Programmes on its website admission.uod.ac.in
2. Admissions to all Two-Year Postgraduate Programmes at the UoD and Non-Collegiate Women Education Board (NCWEB) will be based on the scores obtained in Common University Entrance Test (PG) – 2026.
3. Candidates seeking admission to School of Open Learning (SOL) must visit at www.sol.du.ac.in
4. Foreign Nationals seeking admission to UoD must register at <https://fsr.du.ac.in/>
5. Before registering for CUET (PG) - 2026, the candidate is advised to read the BoI carefully and consult the University of Delhi Act, 1922 and the Statutes and its amendments from time to time. The Ordinances, Rules, and Regulations of the UoD, available on the University website, would be binding to the candidate.
6. Candidates are advised to ascertain that they fulfill the Minimum Eligibility Criteria.
7. Before appearing in CUET (PG) – 2026, candidates must ensure that they fulfill the Programme-Specific Eligibility. They must appear in the CUET paper as per the requirements of the specific programme. For syllabus of the CUET paper, refer to <https://exams.nta.nic.in/cuet-pg/>
8. Candidates appearing in the qualifying degree examination/ candidates whose results are awaited, are eligible to appear in CUET (PG) - 2026. However, they must fulfil the Minimum Eligibility Criteria at the time of admission.
9. Only the scores obtained in CUET (PG) - 2026 will be considered for admissions to Two-Year Postgraduate Programmes at UoD for the academic year 2026-27.
10. Merit will be based solely on the scores obtained in the CUET Test Paper (except for Programmes where Audition test/Practical based test/Sports proficiency test etc. are mandatory) as per the requirement of the specific programme.
11. Candidates are advised to check that they satisfy all eligibility criteria for the programme(s) for which they are appearing in the entrance test. Admission is subject to the candidate's fulfilling the eligibility requirements prescribed for the concerned programme. In case, a candidate does not meet any of the eligibility criteria prescribed for applying to the concerned programme and appears in the entrance test, it is at the candidate's own risk and cost. If at any stage, it is found that eligibility requirement/s is/are not fulfilled, and/or if the claim/s made by the candidate with respect to his/her category, gender, etc. is/are found to be invalid, the admission, if granted, shall be cancelled *ipso facto*. Appropriate legal action will be taken against such a candidate.
12. Candidates seeking admission to the UoD are also required to apply through the University of Delhi's Common Seat Allocation System (Postgraduate)-2026 [CSAS (PG)-2026], as and when notified by the UoD (kindly refer to admission website-admission.uod.ac.in).
13. Candidate must be careful while filling the CUET(PG)-2026 form as certain fields such as Name, signature and photograph of the candidate will be later auto-integrated by UoD from the CUET (PG) -2026 portal. These fields will be non-editable in the UoD's Common Seat Allocation System (PG)-2026.
14. For the purpose of allocation, all candidates will be considered in the common merit list. However, for Category 2(C2) only students of UoD will be considered as per Programme Specific Eligibility.

15. Programmes in which the seats are distributed in Department and Colleges, the allocation of supernumerary seats will be done only in the Departments except in programmes where the teaching is done at colleges only.
16. The University is not bound to fill all the supernumerary seats.
17. In programmes, where the seats are allocated to St. Stephen's College, it is stated that as the matter is sub-judice under the Hon'ble High Court, the distribution of seats may vary.
18. Candidates belonging to SC/ST/OBC-NCL/EWS/PwBD/CW/Orphan/SGC/KM will have to upload a valid certificate/document while applying to UoD's CSAS (PG)-2026. The name of the candidate claiming reservation must match with the candidate's name as it appears on his/her corresponding School/Board/qualifying examination certificates and in CUET (PG)-2026. Similarly, the parents' names must also match in all the certificates/documents.
19. Gap year will not be a bar for the purpose of admission to Two-Year Postgraduate Programmes in UoD.
20. As per Ordinance-I of the University, there is no minimum age bar for admission to the Two-Year Postgraduate Programmes in the UoD and its colleges except in the programmes where the respective regulatory bodies, such as Medical Council of India (MCI), All India Council of Technical Education (AICTE), Bar Council of India (BCI), National Council of Teacher Education (NCTE), Dental Council of India (DCI), etc. have prescribed the minimum age requirement in their respective regulations.
21. Candidates admitted for the academic session 2026–27 will pursue their studies under the Postgraduate Curriculum Framework (PGCF)–2025, formulated in accordance with the National Education Policy (NEP)–2020. They are advised to regularly visit the University of Delhi website for academic and other relevant updates.
22. Candidates are advised to regularly check the admission website (www.admission.uod.ac.in) for all notifications and updates. Any grievance pertaining to candidate's lack of awareness of the published information and updates shall not be entertained.

MINIMUM ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION TO TWO-YEAR POST GRADUATE PROGRAMMES

For candidates belonging to UR/OBC-NCL/EWS category, the minimum eligibility is 50% marks aggregate or equivalent grade in the qualifying examination as per the Programme-Specific Eligibility.

For candidates belonging to SC/ST/PwBD category, the minimum eligibility is 45% marks in aggregate or equivalent grade in the qualifying examination as per the Programme-Specific Eligibility.

*For admissions to the programmes which are governed by the regulations of the regulatory bodies, such as Medical Council of India (MCI), All India Council of Technical Education (AICTE), Bar Council of India (BCI), National Council of Teacher Education (NCTE), Dental Council of India (DCI), etc., the University adheres to the Minimum Eligibility requirements prescribed under the respective regulations of the concerned bodies. Refer to the respective Programme-Specific Eligibility.

RESERVATION POLICIES

RESERVATION OF SEATS FOR SCHEDULED CASTE (SC) AND SCHEDULED TRIBE (ST) CANDIDATES

22.5% of the total number of seats are reserved for candidates belonging to Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribes (15% for Scheduled Caste and 7.5% for Scheduled Tribes, interchangeable if necessary).

The candidate must be in possession of the caste/tribe certificate in his/her own name at the time of registration and admission. The caste certificate should clearly state:

- a) name of caste/tribe
- b) whether candidate belongs to SC or ST
- c) District and the State or Union Territory of candidate's usual place of residence, and
- d) the appropriate Government of India Schedule under which the caste/tribe is approved as SC or ST

Candidate will have to produce the valid original SC/ST certificate at the time of admission. The following are empowered to issue the requisite SC/ST certificate:

- a) District Magistrate/Additional District Magistrate/Collector/Deputy Commissioner/Additional Deputy Commissioner/Deputy Collector/1st class Stipendiary Magistrate/City Magistrate/Sub-Divisional Magistrate/Taluka Magistrate/Executive Magistrate / Extra Assistant Commissioner District Magistrate/Additional District Magistrate/Collector/Deputy Commissioner/Additional Deputy Commissioner/Deputy Collector/1st class Stipendiary Magistrate/City Magistrate/Sub-Divisional Magistrate/Taluka Magistrate/Executive Magistrate / Extra Assistant Commissioner
- b) Chief Presidency Magistrate/Additional Chief Presidency Magistrate/Presidency Magistrate
- c) Revenue Officer not below the rank of Tehsildar
- d) Sub-Divisional Officer of the area where the candidate and/ or his family normally resides
- e) Administrator/Secretary to the Administrator/Development Officer (Lakshadweep Islands)

Candidates to note that the SC/ST certificate from any other person/authority shall not be accepted in any case. If the candidate happens to belong to SC or ST, candidate's caste / tribe must be listed in the appropriate Government of India Schedule.

It is a statutory obligation on the part of Departments/Colleges to fill all seats reserved for Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribe candidates.

Departments/Colleges/Institutes/Centers shall not refuse admission to any SC/ST candidate on the basis of medium of instruction. Any deficiency in the knowledge of any particular language should be addressed; for this purpose, remedial classes may be arranged by the Department/College by utilizing grants available from University Grants Commission.

RESERVATION OF SEATS FOR OTHER BACKWARD CLASSES (OBC NON-CREAMY LAYER)

27% of seats are reserved for candidates belonging to Other Backward Classes (OBC-Non-Creamy Layer, Central List).

At the time of giving admission to a candidate belonging to OBC-NCL, the Departments/Colleges/Centres will ensure that the caste is included in the Central List of OBC (the OBC status is to be determined on the basis of the Central List of OBCs (Government of India) notified by the Ministry of Social Justice and

Empowerment on the recommendations of the National Commission for Backward Classes (available at the website <http://ncbc.nic.in/backward classes/index.html>).

The certificate must mention non-creamy layer status of the candidate (non-creamy layer status issued by an authority mentioned in DoPT Office Memorandum no. 36012/22/93- Estt. (SCT) dated 15.11.1993).

The OBC candidates who belong to the 'Non-Creamy Layer' and **whose caste appears in the Central List of the OBCs only**, shall be eligible to be considered for admission under the OBC category (Validity period of OBC certificate in respect of 'non-creamy layer' status of the Candidates as per DoPT Office Memorandum No. 36036/2/2013-Estt. (Res- I) dated 31st March 2016). The Non-Creamy Layer (NCL) certificate should be issued after **31st March, 2026**.

It is a statutory obligation on the part of Departments/Centres/Colleges to fill all the seats reserved for OBC-NCL candidates.

RESERVATION POLICY FOR ECONOMICALLY WEAKER SECTIONS (EWS)

As per the University of Delhi notifications (Reference No. Aca. I/Reservation of EWSs/2019/63 Dated 28th March 2019 and Reference No. Aca. I/Reservation of EWSs/2019 /101 Dated 15th May 2019), for the reservation for Economically Weaker Sections (EWSs) Category, the University Departments/Centres/Colleges have reserved 10% seats for admission of candidates belonging to EWS category. The EWS certificate should be issued after **31st March, 2026**.

ADMISSION TO SUPERNUMERARY SEATS

Admission to all supernumerary seats will be through CUET (PG)-2026. Candidates desirous of taking admission on supernumerary seats must appear in CUET (PG)-2026.

Programmes in which the seats are distributed in Department and multiple Colleges, the allocation of Supernumerary seats will be done in the departments only (except in Programmes where the teaching is done in college/centres only)

Following supernumerary seats are offered by University of Delhi for admissions to Two-Year Post Graduate Programme:

- Children/Widows of Personnel of the Armed Forces including Para-Military (CW)
- Kashmiri Migrants (KM)
- Orphans Quota (OQ)
- Persons with Benchmark Disabilities (PwBD)
- Single Girl Child (SGC)
- Sports (wherever applicable)
- Ward Quota of Employees of University of Delhi (WQ)

CHILDREN/WIDOWS OF PERSONNEL OF THE ARMED FORCES (CW)

Candidates desirous of taking admission under the CW quota of the University must appear in CUET (PG)-2026.

Five percent (5%) of the total sanctioned strength in each Two-Year Postgraduate Programme of all Departments/Colleges/Centres, are reserved for CW candidates.

All such Candidates have to upload the Educational Concession Certificate (ECC) issued by any of the following authorities on the proper letterhead:

- (a) Secretary, Kendriya Sainik Board, Delhi
- (b) Secretary, Rajya Zila Sainik Board
- (c) Officer-in-Charge, Record Office
- (d) 1st Class Stipendiary Magistrate
- (e) Ministry of Home Affairs (For Police Personnel in receipt of Gallantry Awards)

No other format shall be permissible. Proofs of the CW category in the form of ID card of parent or dependent, medical card, ration card, CSD card, etc. are not admissible in lieu of certificate in correct format. The priority must be clearly mentioned in the certificate. Certificates that do not mention the relevant priority will not be considered*.

Admission may be offered to the Children/Widows of Personnel of the Armed Forces (Priority I to IX) including Para- Military Personnel (only Priority I to V), in the following order of preference:

Priority I	Widows/Wards of Defence personnel killed in action
Priority II	Wards of Defence Personnel disabled in action and boarded out from service with disability attributable to military service

Priority III	Widows/Wards of Defence Personnel who died while in service with death attributable to military service
Priority IV	Wards of Defence Personnel disabled in service and boarded out with disability attributable to military service
Priority V	<p>Wards of Ex-servicemen and Serving personnel, including personnel of police forces who are in receipt of Gallantry Awards</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> i) Param Vir Chakra ii) Ashok Chakra iii) Maha Vir Chakra iv) Kirti Chakra v) Vir Chakra vi) Shaurya Chakra vii) President's Police Medal for Gallantry/President Gallantry Medal for the fire services personnel (up to 25.01.2024)/President's Medal for Gallantry (PMG) for Police and Fire Services (with effect from 26.01.2024) viii) Sena Medal (Gallantry), Nau Sena Medal (Gallantry), Vayu Sena Medal (Gallantry)/Tatrakshak Medal (Gallantry) ix) Mention-in-Despatches x) Police Medal for Gallantry/Gallantry Medal for fire services (up to 25.01.2024)/Medal of Gallantry (GM) for Police and Fire Services (with effect from 26.01.2024)

KASHMIRI MIGRANTS (KM)

Candidates desirous of taking admission to Two-Year Postgraduate Programme under the Kashmiri Migrants quota must appear in CUET (PG) - 2026.

Upto 5% seats are reserved programme-wise in all Departments/Colleges/Centres for the wards of Kashmiri Migrants. All the wards of Kashmiri Migrants will have to upload a certificate of registration as Kashmiri Migrants issued by Divisional Commissioner/Relief Commissioner.

ORPHANS QUOTA (OQ)

Candidates desirous of taking admission to Two-Year Postgraduate Programme under the supernumerary quota for Orphans must appear in CUET (PG) - 2026.

The University of Delhi will be admitting **two candidates** (one male and one female) in each programme of study, both at the Undergraduate and Postgraduate level. These two seats will be supernumerary. The Council of the University further resolved that the expenditure incurred for admission and continuance of study of such students in the University or its Colleges shall be met from the University Welfare Fund or College Students' Welfare Fund, as the case may be, for admissions in the University or in the College.

PERSONS WITH BENCHMARK DISABILITIES (PwBD)

Five percent (5%) of the total sanctioned strength in each Programme are reserved for PwBD candidates.

Separate Allocation result/s will be declared for candidates seeking admission under PwBD quota.

For the format of PwBD certificate, refer to Admission website www.admission.uod.ac.in. Disability Certificates issued after 01.06.2021 must be as per the Gazette Notification no. 1736 (E) dated 05.05.2021 issued by the Department of Empowerment of Persons with Disabilities and applied through UDID porta. However, Disability Certificates issued before 01.06.2021, will be considered as per other existing applicable rules and notifications of the Department of Empowerment of Persons with Disabilities and the University of Delhi.

As per the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016, a 'persons with benchmark disability means a person with not less than forty percent (40%) of a specified disability where specified disability has not been defined in measurable terms and includes a person with disability where specified disability has been defined in measurable terms, as certified by the certifying authority'. It may be noted that the erstwhile Persons with Disabilities (Equal Opportunities, Protection of Rights and Full Participation) Act, 1995 (No. 1 of 1996), under which reservation for Persons with Disabilities in admissions was provided earlier has now been repealed.

Person with benchmark disabilities falling within any of the following specified categories of disabilities as mentioned in the Schedule to the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016 [2016 See Clause (zc) of Section 2 of the said Act] are eligible to get the benefit of the said reservation.

1. Physical disability

A. Locomotor Disability

Locomotor disability (a person's inability to execute distinctive activities associated with movement of self and objects resulting from affliction of musculoskeletal or nervous system or both), including-

- (a) **"leprosy cured persons"** means a person who has been cured of leprosy but is suffering from-
 - (i) loss of sensation in hands or feet as well as loss of sensation and paresis in the eye and eye-lid but with no manifestation of deformity;
 - (ii) manifest deformity and paresis but having sufficient mobility in their hands and feet to enable them to engage in normal economic activity;
 - (iii) extreme physical deformity as well as advanced age which prevents him/her from undertaking any gainful occupation, and the expression "leprosy cured" shall be construed accordingly;
- (b) **"cerebral palsy"** means a Group of non-progressive neurological condition affecting body movements before, during or shortly after birth;
- (c) **"dwarfism"** means a medical or genetic condition resulting in an adult height of 4 feet 10 inches (147 centimeters) or less;

- (d) "**muscular dystrophy**" means a group of hereditary genetic muscle disease that weakens the muscles that move the human body and persons with multiple dystrophy have incorrect and missing information in their genes, which prevents them from making the proteins they need for healthy muscles. It is characterized by progressive skeletal muscle weakness, defects in muscle proteins, and the death of muscle cells and tissue;
- (e) "**acid attack victims**" means a person disfigured due to violent assaults by throwing of acid or similar corrosive substance.

B. Visual impairment

- (a) "**blindness**" means a condition where a person has any of the following conditions, after best correction
 - (i) total absence of sight;
 - (ii) visual acuity less than 3/60 or less than 10/200 (Snellen) in the better eye with best possible correction; or
 - (iii) limitation of the field of vision subtending an angle of less than 10 degree.
- (b) "**low-vision**" means a condition where a person has any of the following conditions, namely:
 - (i) visual acuity not exceeding 6/18 or less than 20/60 upto 3/60 or upto 10/200 (Snellen) in the better eye with best possible corrections; or
 - (ii) limitation of the field of vision subtending an angle of less than 40 degree upto 10 degree.

C Hearing impairment

- (a) "**deaf**" means persons having 70 DB hearing loss in speech frequencies in both ears;
- (b) "**hard of hearing**" means person having 60 DB to 70 DB hearing loss in speech frequencies in both ears;
- D "**speech and language disability**" means a permanent disability arising out of conditions such as laryngectomy or aphasia affecting one or more components of speech and language due to organic or neurological causes.

2. Intellectual disability

A condition characterized by significant limitation both in intellectual functioning (reasoning, learning, problem solving) and in adaptive behavior which covers a range of everyday, social and practical skills, including-

- (a) "**specific learning disabilities**" means a heterogeneous group of conditions wherein there is a deficit in processing language, spoken or written, that may manifest itself as a difficulty to comprehend, speak, read, dyslexia, dysgraphia, dyscalculia, dyspraxia and developmental aphasia;
- (b) "**autism spectrum disorder**" means a neuro-developmental condition typically appearing in the first three years of life that significantly affects a person's ability to communicate, understand relationships and relate to others, and is frequently associated with unusual or stereotypical rituals or behaviours.

3. Mental behavior

"mental illness" means a substantial disorder of thinking, mood, perception, orientation or memory that grossly impairs judgment, behaviours, capacity to recognize reality or ability to meet the ordinary demands of life, but does not include retardation which is a condition of arrested or incomplete development of mind of a person, specially characterized by subnormality of intelligence.

4. Disability caused due to

- (a) chronic neurological conditions, such as-
 - (i) "**multiple sclerosis**" means an inflammatory, nervous system disease in which the myelin sheaths around the axons of nerve cells of the brain and spinal cord are damaged, leading to demyelination and affecting the ability of nerve cells in the brain and spinal cord to communicate with each other.
 - (ii) "**parkinson's disease**" means a progressive disease of the nervous system marked by tremor, muscular rigidity and slow, imprecise movement, chiefly affecting middle-aged and elderly

people associated with degeneration of the basal ganglia of the brain and a deficiency of the neurotransmitter dopamine.

(b) Blood disorder

- (i) “**haemophilia**” means an inheritable disease, usually affecting only male but transmitted by women to their malechildren, characterized by loss or impairment of the normal clotting ability of blood so that a minor wound may result in fatal bleeding.
- (ii) “**thalassemia**” means a group of inherited disorders characterised by reduced or absent amounts of haemoglobin.
- (iii) “**sickle cell disease**” means a haemolytic disorder characterised by chronic anaemia, painful events, and the cell membrane of red blood cells resulting in the release of haemoglobin.

5. Multiple Disabilities (more than one of the above specified disabilities) including deaf blindness which means a condition in which a person may have combination of hearing and visual impairments causing severe communication, developmental, and educational problems.

6. Any other category as may be notified by the Central Government.

Concessional/waiver of fees in respect of PwBD

- a. Candidates with physical disabilities pursuing various programmes of study in the Faculties, Departments, Centres, and Institutions/Colleges of the University shall be exempted from payment of fees, including examination fee and other University fees, except admission fee, subscription towards Delhi University Students' Union (DUSU) and Identity Card fee (As per amendment to Ordinance X (4) of the University).
- b. As per University Notification vide no. Acad.I/PG Fee/PwBD/2022-23 dt.30.11.2022 the candidates belonging to PwBD category for PG Programmes shall be given a fee concession of 75% of the total fees as compared to the other students taking admission in a particular programme of the University.
- c. PwBD Candidates who meet the merit for the unreserved category and will take admission in the Unreserved/ OBC-NCL/SC/ST/EWS category will pay the fee relevant for PwBD candidate.
- d. As per the Executive Council Resolution No. 50 dated 03.11.2012, students with physical disabilities residing in different Hostels / Halls of the University are exempted from payment of all hostel fees and charges except refundable caution fee and the mess fees. Persons with Physical Disabilities who are students shall pay 50% of the Mess fee and the remaining 50% of their Mess Fee will be met by the University of Delhi. Similar norms are to be adopted by the Colleges in respect of PwBD Students residing in various hostels of the Colleges.
- e. Candidates must ensure that the PwBD certificate is in the name of the candidate and issued by a recognized Government Hospital, bearing duly attested photograph of the candidate.
- f. PwBD students who are getting fellowships / financial assistance shall be exempted from payment of fees / charges / mess fees subject to the following conditions.

Upto 3000/- per month	Fees waiver +50% Mess Subsidy
3001/- to 8000/- per month	Fees waiver but no Mess Subsidy
8001/- and above per month	No fees waiver and no Hostel Subsidy

SINGLE GIRL CHILD (SGC)

Candidates desirous of taking admission to Two-Year Postgraduate Programme under the single girl child quota must appear in CUET (PG)-2026.

01 (one) seat in each Two-Year Postgraduate Programme of every department is reserved under the supernumerary quota for a single girl child. For claiming admission in this category, the

father/mother/guardian (in case parents are deceased) shall have to upload copy of an affidavit to this effect, duly attested by the area District Magistrate/Additional Magistrate/Deputy Commissioner/Collector/Additional Deputy Commissioner/Deputy Collector/1stClass Stipendiary Magistrate/City Magistrate (not below the rank of 1stClass Stipendiary Magistrate), Sub-Divisional Magistrate/Taluka Magistrate/Executive Magistrate/Extra Assistant Commissioner, at the time of online registration and should produce original affidavit at the time of physical verification of documents.

SPORTS QUOTA

Candidates desirous of taking admission to Two-Year Postgraduate Programme under the sports quota must appear in CUET (PG) - 2026.

The University earmarks up to 5% (of total intake capacity of the Department/College) as supernumerary seats in Two-year Post Graduate Programme in Sports Quota.

Admission on the basis of Sports is not applicable in the programmes of Master of Library and Information Science, Bachelor of Education, B.Ed. Special Education (ID/VI), Master of Education, M.Tech. Microwaves and Communication, Master of Physical Education, LL.B, LL.M, Master of Computer Application, M.A. Social Work, M.Sc. Mathematical Education, Master of Respiratory Therapy, M.A. Chinese, M.A. Hindu Studies, Master in Physiotherapy and Master in Public Health.

For admissions to Sports supernumerary seats a weightage of 25% will be given to CUET(PG)-2026 score and 75% to certificates/trials/performances.

Additional information regarding sports trials etc. will be notified on the University of Delhi website.

WARD QUOTA OF EMPLOYEES OF UNIVERSITY OF DELHI

Candidates desirous of taking admission to Two-Year Postgraduate Programme under the Ward Quota of Employees of University of Delhi must appear in CUET (PG)-2026.

Admission to the wards of University and its College employees, both teaching and non-teaching will be done as per Academic Council resolution 9 a & b dated 27.11.2020 and subsequent amendments thereof.

Candidates must be in possession of a valid Employment Certificate issued by competent authorities at the time of registration. Only the Employment Certificate uploaded in CSAS (PG)- 2026 will be considered. Identity card, Aadhar card and/or any other document will not be accepted.

REGISTRATION/ADMISSION OF FOREIGN NATIONALS

All candidates holding a foreign passport including those who have completed their previous qualifying degree from an Indian University/Board will be treated as Foreign Candidates for the purpose of their Registration/Admission in various Departments/Colleges/Centres of the University and they will be considered for admission under the quota (As per AC resolution No. 304) prescribed for the foreign students. The Foreign Candidates seeking admission to Two-Year Postgraduate Programmes need to apply through Foreign Students' Registry Portal <http://fsr.du.ac.in>. No Foreign student will be admitted directly by the Department / Colleges.

The foreign nationals are exempted from appearing in CUET (PG) -2026. Admission in foreign students' category shall be done on the basis of Merit.

All the foreign candidate shall come under the same category of 10% admission quota for foreign nationals. This shall include foreign nationals with qualification from an Indian Board / University as well as from any Foreign Board / University.
